



Professional and Technical qualifications are also known as BTEC's or vocational qualifications. They are practical qualifications often linked to career pathways, higher degree apprenticeships or university. They are college based, but you'll learn in industry standard settings such as workshops, salons, studios, stables, gardens... it depends on which course you study.

Here is what is special about **Technical and Professional** courses...

1. Technical and Professional courses link to careers

As the name suggests, these courses usually relate to specific 'vocations', i.e. careers or job roles. For example, if you want to fix aeroplanes, you can take an Aerospace Engineering course, a future chef can study Professional Hospitality, a wannabe landscape gardener could pursue a Horticulture course, or an aspiring filmmaker can gain the skills they need on a Media course. Whatever your ambition, there's a course to get you started!

2. Technical and Professional courses are hands on

Unlike most GCSEs, technical and professional courses are practical and help you learn how to do things. You

will spend some time in class exploring theory, but you will also be in workshops, studios, labs or the great outdoors, depending on the subject you choose. You'll also compete work experience, so you can put your new knowledge into practice!

4. Technical and Professional students can build up their skills

College may be the first chance you've had to do some of these subjects, but don't worry. BTC will help you begin with a course that suits your current level of knowledge, then work your way up. Some subjects start with Level 1, an introductory level which will give you the grounding you need to get started. You can study some vocational subjects right up to degree level and beyond at BTC!

5. Technical and Professional students can go to university

If you achieve good results in a Level 3 technical/professional course, you may be able to apply for a vocational course at university or for a Degree Apprenticeship. Check the entry requirements before choosing what to do after school.

6. Technical and Professional courses include English and maths

English and maths are essential in all walks of life and careers, especially if you hope to own your own business one day. If needed, you may be able to take English and maths qualifications alongside your main vocational subject.

7. Technical and Professional students use state-of-the-art facilities

At school, you'll have spent a lot of time in classrooms. If you choose a vocational course, you'll learn in industry-standard settings, designed like real-life workplaces.
