

Established in the 1920s the awards provide grants to people studying courses related to the dairy industry.

Funds are available to students of all ages who are undertaking further education courses related to the dairy industry.

Sons and daughters of farmers or farm employees, or students who can demonstrate commitment to the dairy industry and show aptitude to 'add value' to the industry, shall be considered.

Applicants must live in one of the following four counties:- Cornwall, Devon, Dorset or Somerset.

The awards distribute over £15,000 every year. All qualifying applicants receive some funding and the best four receive between £1,000 and £2,000 each.

All applicants are interviewed within their county and the best are invited to a Final Interview Day, usually held in September.

Applications close on 31st July each year.
