

# VULNERABLE GROUPS BURSARY 2021/2022

Students under 19 and who are considered to be vulnerable young students may be eligible for up to £1,200 (essential course fees will be deducted from this at where applicable) this award is based on students studying a programme of at least 30 week duration, students studying less than this may be eligible for a proportional award. Access to funds will be assessed on individual students financial need, it is not an automatic entitlement based on eligibility. The following criteria apply for this bursary:

- Young Person currently in Local Authority Care
- Young Person Leaving Care
- Young Person in receipt of Income Support or Universal Credit
- Young Person in receipt of Universal Credit (restrictions apply)
- Young Person in receipt of both Employment Support Allowance or Universal Credit and Personal Independence Payment
- Unaccompanied asylum seeking children (under 18) who are under Local Authority care.
